#### **CHILDREN**

Serving babies through 5th graders, our juvenile collection has board books, easy readers, graphic novels, puppets, puzzles and more. Use a tablet, read an interactive story, or engage in creative play at the Lite Brite wall!



#### **TFFN**

Our Young Adult collection is designed for readers in 6th grade and up. Come explore our new Teen Center equipped with private study rooms, reserved teen seating and a dedicated Teen Services librarian.

# Explore Des Moines with Adventure Pass

Iowa Libraries provide free passes to area attractions for a day of family fun! Passes allow entrance for two (2) adults and two (2) children.



- For WDM Library: WDM residents, 18 years or age and older, with a valid library card that is non-expired and in good standing may reserve passes by using TixKeeper.
- Cardholder must present a valid photo ID and printed pass (email on phone not accepted) before admission into the venue is allowed.
- One pass per venue may be reserved once every 365 days.
- Passes cannot be used for any other special member events (e.g. Zoo Brew or Night Eyes)
- Please cancel your reservation if you cannot use the pass at the reserved time. To cancel a reservation, call the Reference Desk at 515-222-3403.

# **Library Card Facts**

Individuals who fill out a Library Card Application and present a valid ID with proof of Identification and Current Residence may have a library card free of charge. Library card applications are available in-person or online via our Library Card Pre-Registration Form.

#### LIMITS

Library card holders may check out as many items as they wish, with the following exceptions:

- Magazines: 10 per card holder
- Popular DVDs: 10 per card holder
- S.T.E.M. Kits: 1 per card holder
- Meet Your Neighbor Kit: 1 per card holder

#### **LOAN PERIODS**

The usual borrowing period is three (3) weeks. Reference materials and newspapers do not circulate. You'll find copy machines for your convenience on both floors.

#### RENEWALS

Most items can be renewed twice (in person, by phone, or by accessing your account online). Don't forget to try a self-check station located near the Checkout & Accounts desk. Magazines and reserved items cannot be renewed.

#### **FINES & FEES**

- If items are more than 42 days overdue borrowing privilege's will be suspended until these items have returned or their replacement costs have been paid.
- Accounts with items that are 2 months overdue will be turned over to a collection agency to recover or replace:
  - The item or items
  - Plus any fines owed to the library
  - Plus an additional \$10 recovery fee
- If library materials are lost or damaged, the borrower must pay the replacement fee determined by the library or provide a replacement copy identical to the original.
